	The fees were discussed. On the proposition of Cllr Dutton, seconded by Cllr Andrews and agreed by all that Exclusive Right of burial must be purchased at the time of interment. The following fees should also be increased; On the proposition of Cllr Dutton, seconded by Cllr Coates and agreed by all that the Interment of cremated remains will rise from £100 to £125. On the proposition of Cllr Dutton, seconded by Cllr Griffiths and agreed by all that the Exclusive Right of Burial on an ashes plot should rise from £100 to £125. On the proposition of Cllr Dutton, seconded by Cllr Holdom and agreed by all that the Exclusive Right of burial on a burial plot should rise from £150 to £175. These new fees will take effect from 1 <sup>st</sup> June 2021.
