9	<b>FAKENHAM POLICE</b> Inspector Cooper-Barnes stated that the police are currently investigating the arson and vandalism that took place on Greenway Lane allotment site on Sunday evening. They will be contacting the tenants affected and will be giving advice regarding security etc. The inspector will email the Town Clerk with the details of which plots were affected. One plot in particular was particularly badly affected with a new shed and all the tools contained in it burnt to the ground. Others had a years' worth of work destroyed.  B&Q have kindly donated money-off vouchers for those tenants whose sheds were broken in to, to help with making the repairs.
