166	TO CONSIDER APPLICATIONS FOR PLANNING PERMISSION  PA 4459 (PF/21/0778) – Change of use of former Press Club to 3 dwellings and associated parking; external alterations; demolition of single-storey lean-to extension, part of single storey north wing and wall to Oak Street – 37-39 Oak Street, NR21 9DX. NNDC case officer: Natalie Levett.  Councillors welcome the chance of improving this run-down section of Oak Street however the Council objects to the application as they feel it should be two dwellings rather than three. The Council would also ask that when the application is granted they would like to see a Traffic Management Plan.  PA 4460 (PF/21/0799) – Change of use of upper floors over shops to form three flats including demolition and alterations to rear elevation - 6-8 & 10 Norwich Street, NR21 9AE. NNDC case officer: Jayne Owen.  Councillors offered no objection and no comment.		

PA 4444 (PF/20/0065) – Use of land to provide extension to self-storage containe site; relocation of fence to existing west boundary to new west boundary fence; extension of fence to southern boundary; extension 4m high bund to the southern boundary; and associated works to facilitate the development – 3 Wymans Way, NR21 8NT.
