There has been inappropriate vehicle behaviour on Oak Street. The Clerk confirmed that the Town Council has been awarded part funding from Norfolk County Council (NCC) for a SAM 2 sign. A Councillor has concerns that several delivery vans are breaking the road closure on a Thursday and coming through Norwich Street into Bridge Street.
