	Mr Appleton expressed his wish to build a supportive relationship between allotment

holders and the Town Council. It was noted that regular inspections are important to maintain plots, and that communication between the Council and plot holders should be approached sensitively and work both ways, with assistance offered where possible.

It was noted that a number of allotment plots are vacant.

The numbering of plots is progressing, with numbers having been ordered. Mr Combrink will cut the wooden discs and advise the office of the number and dimensions of stakes required.

Rudham Stile Lane

Concern was raised regarding the lack of fencing or hedging between the allotment site and the neighbouring site that has been cleared for development. The contractor removed the existing hedge and has not carried out any reinstatement work. The area is now overgrown with weeds, which are spreading onto the allotments. It was noted that the contractors currently appear to be uncontactable.

Mr Tomlinson advised that he is resigning as Tenant Representative for Rudham Stile Lane. The Committee expressed their thanks to Mr Tomlinson for his valued contribution over the years.

ACTION: The RFO to arrange for the Tenant Representative vacancy to be advertised on the Rudham Stile Lane allotment noticeboard
